OMA recognizes a variety of programs that are designed to be on-ramps to manufacturing careers. In this presentation, participants will learn about four programs designed to be on-ramps and development pipelines to Ohio manufacturing careers, including:

Career Connections - A framework by which students develop a vision and realistic plan for their futures, during K-12 and beyond. Career Connections Learning strategies are embedded into Ohio's New Learning Standards for English language arts, math, science and social studies.

IGNITE: Mastering Manufacturing - A three-year high school curriculum that prepares students for careers or continuing education in advanced manufacturing. IGNITE blends interactive multimedia learning with virtual simulations and provides students the opportunity to learn through project-based experiences built around real industry problems and challenges.

The **Manufacturing Foundation Certificate** is a statewide program, supported by the Ohio Engineering Technology Educators Association, which prepares students for entry-level positions in manufacturing.

ApprenticeOhio recognizes pre-apprenticeship programs that partner with Registered Apprenticeship sponsors to create career pathways for participants. The certification process is designed for pre-apprenticeship providers to understand the skills needed for participants to be prepared for a nationally certified Registered Apprenticeship program.
