In an effort to create a pipeline of skilled multi-craft industrial technicians, Honda partnered with Columbus State Community College (CSCC) to create an alternative to a more traditional internship program.

The result is a work-based learning model that provides students with a career pathway into one of the most in-demand careers in Ohio: manufacturing.

Students have the opportunity to learn *and* earn, greatly reducing college debt while developing skills that lead to a rewarding high-wage career in manufacturing.

The program has grown from one participating company with six students to more than 25 companies with nearly 50 students.
