E-Verify’s New Look and Enhancements

What will be covered? E-Verify is the free web-based service administered by U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Service (USCIS) and the Social Security Administration (SSA) that allows enrolled employers to electronically verify the employment eligibility of their new hires. From the federal perspective, E-Verify is voluntary for most users although mandatory, in some form or fashion, in over 20 states (which includes IN) and for a host of federal contractors. We’ll review E-Verify’s new look and enhancements (launched in Apr 2018), when’s the earliest you can create a case in E-Verify, the tentative non-confirmation process, how you can check your ‘own’ work eligibility (myE-Verify) along with some advance *good to know* tips.
