






Greenhouse Innovation




Investing in Ohio

There are over 275 Canadian-owned companies operating in the Buckeye State and the numbers keep growing. These companies are responsible for over 26,500 jobs throughout the state. According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, the average salary in the state of Ohio is \$44,750. This means that Canadian-owned companies are responsible for \$1.2 billion in salary dollars! Therefore, not only do Canadian companies pay their taxes locally, they also contribute to the local economy through these salary dollars. 
