After much delay, OSHA is moving forward with its requirement to electronically submit your OSHA 300A information.

If you haven't yet submitted, you have until December 1, 2017 to submit your 2016 records.

There are three options for data submission

1. Manual data entry
2. Uploading a CSV file
3. Electronic data transfer via API
