



**Proponent Testimony  
Before the House Commerce and Labor Committee  
House Bill 574  
November 29, 2016**

Mr. Chairman and members of the House Commerce and Labor Committee, I am pleased to offer testimony in support of House Bill 574 (H.B. 574) on behalf of the Ohio Manufacturers' Association (OMA).

As you may know, Ohio ranks in the top four states for manufacturing economy. Within Ohio's leading economic sector, transportation equipment manufacturing employs 122,600 Ohioans. Plastics and rubber products manufacturing employs another 56,000 Ohioans. In short, a lot of family-sustaining jobs are directly tied to car, truck and automotive parts production.

H.B. 574 is intended to help protect and grow those jobs and the economic investment by companies and to keep it in Ohio versus other states or provinces.

Tires manufactured today enjoy a lot of embedded technologies from years of product innovation resulting in greater safety for motorists and roadways. The manufacturers must comply with federal uniform government safety specifications.

Industry leaders have identified a problem with too many unsafe used tires entering the stream of commerce, available for installation to a motoring public who may not be aware of their unsafe condition.

In an effort to protect against unsafe driving, the tire manufacturers have suggested this legislation to better prevent the installation of unsafe used tires and provide enhanced public safety. We endorse their recommendation.
