ABOUT US

Since 1981, the UD-IAC has helped over 850 small to mid-sized industries reduce energy costs and stay competitive.

As part of an assessment, a small team of faculty and graduate students trained in industrial best practices will visit your facility for a single day and compile a customized report with recommendations for reducing energy costs.

Our energy assessments typically identify energy savings opportunities that reduce total annual energy usage, cost, and associated carbon emissions by 10-15%.

HOW TO QUALIFY

To qualify for a free assessment, your plant must have:

- SIC Code between 2000 3999
- Annual energy bills between \$100,000 \$2.5 million
- No professional in-house staff to perform an assessment

And either:

- Gross annual sales below \$100 million, or
- Fewer than 500 employees
