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### **AEP Ohio**

#### **AEP Ohio Decreases LGR Rider (Case No. 20-1118-EL-RDR)**

**Summary:** AEP Ohio filed a notice to decrease its LGR Rider (aka OVEC rider) rate, which will result in decreases to customer bills. For commercial and industrial customers, the LGR Rider rate will now be a credit of \$0.00021/kWh, compared to the previous charge of \$0.000834/kWh.

### **AES Ohio**

#### **AES Ohio Decreases LGR Rider (Case No. 22-547-EL-RDR)**

**Summary:** AES Ohio filed an application to update its LGR Rider (aka OVEC rider) rate, which will result in decreases to customer bills. For commercial and industrial customers, the LGR Rider rate will now be a credit of \$0.000218/kWh, compared to the previous credit of \$0.000052/kWh.

### **Columbia Gas**

#### **Columbia Updates Standard Choice Offer (SCO) Rate**

**Summary:** Due to recent increases in natural gas costs, Columbia has raised its SCO rate to \$1.05580 per ccf. The SCO rate applies to customers who do not take natural gas supply from a competitive supplier. Customers should check their competitive supplier contracts before choosing not to shop and switching to the default service.

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## Duke

### **Duke Files Notice of Application to Increase Natural Gas Rates (Case Nos. 22-507-GA-AIR, et al.)**

**Summary:** Duke filed a notice of intent to file with the PUCO an application for approval of an increase in natural gas rates; an application for an alternative rate plan; an application for tariff approval; and a related application to change accounting methods.

## FirstEnergy

### **PUCO Approves Reasonable Arrangements With FirstEnergy**

**Summary:** Two mercantile customers received approval of reasonable arrangements with FirstEnergy to participate in FirstEnergy's Rider NMB Opt-out Pilot Program.

### **FirstEnergy Updates Various Riders**

**Summary:** Each of the FirstEnergy utilities will update several riders to new rates that are identical for each utility. Each of the utilities will:

- Increase the Generation Cost Reconciliation (GCR) Rider to \$0.0571/kWh for General Service – Primary (GP) and \$0.0591/kWh for General Service – Secondary (GS) from \$(0.1353)/kWh for GP and \$(0.1402)/kWh for GS;
- Increase the Demand Side Management and Energy Efficiency (DSE) Rider to \$0.0665/kWh from \$0.0580/kWh;
- Decrease the Legacy Generation Resource (LGR) Rider (aka OVEC Rider) to \$0.0036/kWh from \$0.1047/kWh; and,
- Decrease the Delta Revenue Recovery (DRR) Rider to \$(0.0001)/kWh for GP, \$(0.0003)/kWh for GS from \$0.0006/kWh for GP and \$0.0017/kWh for GS.

Furthermore, each of the FirstEnergy utilities will update several riders to new rates, which will differ between the utilities. The Cleveland Illuminating Company will:

- Decrease its Alternative Energy Resource (AER) Rider to \$0.1087/kWh from \$0.1122/kWh;

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- Decrease its Distribution Uncollectible (DUN) Rider to (\$0.0133)/kWh from \$0.0000/kWh;
- Decrease its PIPP Uncollectible Rider (PUR) to \$0.0025/kWh from \$0.0037/kWh;
- Increase its Non-Distribution Uncollectible (NDU) Rider to \$0.0640/kWh from \$0.0573/kWh;
- Decrease its Economic Developer Rider (EDR) to \$0.0571/kWh for GP and \$0.0591 for GS from \$0.4474/kWh for GP and \$0.2695/kWh for GS; and
- Decrease its Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) Rider to \$170.329 per month for GP and \$18.432 per month for GS from \$254.443 per month for GP and \$26.049 per month for GS.

The Ohio Edison Company will:

- Decrease its AER Rider to \$0.0881/kWh from \$0.1271/kWh;
- Decrease its DUN Rider to (\$0.0232)/kWh from \$0.0000/kWh;
- Decrease its PUR Rider to \$0.0018/kWh from \$0.0048/kWh.
- Decrease its NDU Rider to \$0.0034/kWh from \$0.0695/kWh;
- Decrease its EDR Rider to \$0.2105/kWh for GP and \$0.2259 for GS from \$0.2627/kWh for GP and \$0.2822 for GS; and
- Increase its AMI Rider to \$207.312 per month for GP and \$11.145 per month for GS from \$194.078 per month for GP and \$10.479 per month for GS.

Lastly, the Toledo Edison Company will:

- Decrease its AER Rider to \$0.0537/kWh from \$0.1215/kWh;
- Decrease its DUN Rider to (\$0.0278)/kWh from \$0.0000/kWh;
- Decrease its PUR Rider to \$(0.0004)/kWh from \$0.0018/kWh;
- Decrease its NDU Rider to \$(0.0505)/kWh from \$0.0911/kWh.
- Decrease its EDR Rider to \$0.4533/kWh for GP and \$0.1194 for GS from \$0.5656/kWh for GP and \$0.1493/kWh for GS; and,
- Increase its AMI Rider to \$117.302 per month from \$107.300 per month for GP and decrease to \$11.882 per month from \$11.247 per month for GS.
