Duke

OMAEG Participates in Duke Rate Case Hearing (Case Nos. 21-887-EL-AIR, et al.)

Summary: After agreeing to not oppose a settlement filed by almost all parties in the Duke rate case, the hearing on the settlement concluded this week. The Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC) was the only party challenging the settlement that significantly reduces the rate increase proposed by Duke. A briefing schedule has been set, after which the PUCO will render a decision.

Duke Updates its Distribution Storm Rider (Case No. 89-6002-EL-TRF)

Summary: Duke increased a credit for its Distribution Storm Rider to (\$0.0777)/kW from (\$0.03)/kW for Primary and Secondary Distribution Voltage and to (\$0.26)/month from (\$0.12)/month for Secondary Distribution Service-Small. The new credits will go into effect the first billing cycle of November 2022.
