**Supreme Court of Ohio Freezes Randazzo's Assets
(Case Nos. 2022-1286, 20-CV-6281, et al.)**

Summary: In 2021, Attorney General (AG) Yost seized \$8 million in assets from former Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (PUCO) Chairman Samuel Randazzo in connection with his role in the House Bill 6 scandal. Due to a technicality, the 10th District Court of Appeals ordered that those assets be unfrozen. AG Yost appealed the decision to the Supreme Court of Ohio. Earlier this week, the Court overturned the 10th District's ruling and refroze Randazzo's assets.
