AEP Increases Enhanced Service Reliability Rider (ESRR) (Case No. 21-1268-EL-RDR)

Summary: AEP's ESRR charge will increase to 5.90761% of the customer's distribution charges from 3.0707% of the customer's distribution charges.

AEP Rider Adjustments (Case No. 21-1268-EL-RDR)

Summary: AEP has updated its gridSmart and Distribution Investment Riders (DIR). The rider rates, which became effective Dec. 1, 2022, have been adjusted as follows:

- The gridSmart Rider will increase to \$15.89/month from \$15.57/month for non-residential customers; and
- The DIR will decrease to 8.26965% (from 8.52683%) of the customer's distribution charges for all customers.

OMAEG Comments on Non-Market-Based Services Rider (Rider NMB) Update (Case No. 23-0051-EL-RDR)

Summary: The OMAEG submitted [comments](#) regarding FirstEnergy's request to increase the transmission rates under Rider NMB. OMAEG urged the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (PUCO) to revise FirstEnergy's Rider NMB rate mechanism and bill non-residential customers for all transmission costs on the basis of each customer's NSPL, rather than on monthly billing demand. Alternatively, the OMAEG suggested that the Rider NMB Pilot Program be expanded to allow customers to opt-out of Rider NMB so customers are able to manage and control their transmission costs.

**U.S. Attorney Requests Stay of All HB 6 Discovery Proceedings
(Case Nos. 17-0974-EL-UNC, et al.)**

Summary: The U.S. Attorney's office has requested an additional six-month extension of the stay implemented in the FirstEnergy House Bill 6 proceedings, arguing that continued discovery in the PUCO proceedings will directly interfere with or impede the ongoing criminal investigation relating to HB 6.
