IEU Changes Name to Ohio Energy Leadership Council (OELC) (Case Nos. 08-1094-EL-SSO, et al.)

Summary: The group previously known as the Industrial Energy Users-Ohio (IEU-Ohio) has formally notified the PUCO that it has changed its name to Ohio Energy Leadership Council (OELC).

FirstEnergy

FirstEnergy Utilities Update Rider Rates (Case Nos. 89-6001-EL-TRF, 89-6006-EL-TRF, and 89-6008-EL-TRF)

Summary: Each of the FirstEnergy utilities updated their Delta Revenue Recovery Riders (Rider DDR) and Generation Cost Reconciliation (GCR) Riders. They will become effective April 1, 2023. Each of the utilities will:

- Increase Rider DDR to \$0.000001/kWh from \$0.00/kWh for General Service – Primary (GP), and to \$0.000003/kWh from \$0.00/kWh for General Service – Secondary (GS); and
- Increase the GCR Rider to a charge of \$0.001090/kWh from a credit of \$0.002374/kWh for GP, to a charge of \$0.001129/kWh from a credit of \$0.002459/kWh for GS.

Furthermore, each of the FirstEnergy utilities updated several other riders, which will become effective April 1, 2023. The Cleveland Illuminating Company will:

- Increase its Distribution Uncollectible (DUN) Rider to \$0.000770/kWh from \$0.000297/kWh for all customers;

- Increase its PIPP Uncollectible Rider (PUR) to a charge of \$0.000023/kWh from a credit of \$0.000016 for all customers;
- Increase its Economic Developer Rider (EDR) to \$0.005447/kWh from \$0.004609/kWh for GP, and to \$0.003260/kWh \$0.002765/kWh for GS; and
- Increase its Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) Rider to \$177.194 per month from \$163.283 per month for GP, and to \$18.401 per month from \$16.892 per month for GS.

The Ohio Edison Company will:

- Implement a DUN Rider credit of \$0.000423/kWh from a charge of \$0.000318/kWh for all customers;
- Increase its PUR to a charge of \$0.000028/kWh from a credit of \$0.000007/kWh for all customers;
- Increase its EDR to \$0.003192/kWh from \$0.002704/kWh for GP, and to \$0.003413/kWh from \$0.002894/kWh for GS; and
- Increase its AMI Rider to \$191.852 per month from \$191.021 per month for GP, and decrease to \$10.380 per month from \$10.446 per month for GS.

Lastly, the Toledo Edison Company will:

- Implement a DUN Rider credit of \$0.000267/kWh from a charge of \$0.000009/kWh for all customers;
- Increase its PUR to a charge of \$0.000014/kWh from a credit of \$0.000006/kWh for all customers;
- Increase its EDR to \$0.006890/kWh from \$0.005828/kWh for GP, and to \$0.001791/kWh from \$0.001524/kWh for GS; and
- Increase its AMI Rider to \$112.823 per month from \$110.307 per month for GP, and to \$11.346 per month from \$11.028 per month for GS.

Centerpoint Energy (formerly Vectren)

Centerpoint Decreases Default Standard Choice Offer (SCO)

Summary: Based on recent competitive auctions, Centerpoint decreased its default service rate for natural gas to \$0.36926/Ccf from \$0.43966/Ccf. Although the default rate decreased, customers should continue to check their competitive supplier contracts before choosing not to shop and switching to the SCO.

Columbia Gas

Columbia Decreases Default Standard Choice Offer Rate

Summary: Based on recent competitive auctions, Columbia decreased its default service rate for natural gas to \$0.41010/Ccf from \$0.47590/Ccf. Although the default rate decreased, customers should continue to check their competitive supplier contracts before choosing not to shop and switching to the SCO.
