FirstEnergy Proposes Updates to Rider NMB (Case No. 21-695-EL-RDR)

Summary: FirstEnergy proposed updates to its non-bypassable Non-market Based Services Rider, which recovers transmission-related fees or charges imposed on FirstEnergy by PJM or FERC.

If approved, the following rates will become effective on a service-rendered basis beginning Sept. 1, 2021.

- **GS:** \$6.5425/kW, a decrease from \$6.8854/kW.
- **GP:** \$7.0054/kW, a decrease from \$7.3128/kW.
- **GSU:** \$5.9977/kVa, a decrease from \$6.1746/kVa.
- **GT:** \$6.6161/kVa, an increase from \$5.6987/kVa.

AES Ohio (formerly DP&L)

OMAEG Opposes AES Ohio's Request to Defer Decoupling Revenues (Case No. 20-140-EL-AAM)

Summary: OMAEG submitted a [brief](#) advocating that the PUCO should reject AES Ohio's unlawful request to defer decoupling revenues pursuant to a settlement that the company breached. Specifically, the brief explained how AES Ohio has no existing legal authorization to collect or defer decoupling revenues, and how the energy efficiency programs, which were the primary justification for decoupling, have since been terminated pursuant to HB 6.
