DP&L Proposes Increase to Tax Savings Credit (Case No. 19-568-EL-ATA)

Summary: The Tax Savings Credit (TSC) is assessed as a percentage of base distribution charges on each monthly bill and applies to secondary, primary, primary substation, and high voltage customers. DP&L proposed increasing the credit to a rider rate of -4.2735% of base distribution charges from the previous rate of -2.6679% of base distribution charges. If approved, the new credit would become effective on a bill's rendered basis starting on Oct. 1, 2020.

FirstEnergy Increases Rider DCR Rates (Case No. 19-1759-EL-RDR)

Summary: The PUCO approved an increase for FirstEnergy for the following rates for its Delivery Capital Recovery Rider (Rider DCR), effective on a bill's rendered basis starting Sept. 1, 2020, and not avoidable for customers who take electric generation service from a certified supplier:

- General Service — Secondary (GS): \$5.0998 per kW of billing demand; increased from \$4.3993 per kW of billing demand.
- General Service — Primary (GP): \$1.6616 per kW of billing demand; increased from \$1.4416 per kW of billing demand.
- General Service — Sub-Transmission (GSU): \$1.2606 per kW of billing demand; increased from \$1.0421 per kW of billing demand.
