Columbia

Parties Reach Settlement on PHMSA IRP Case (Case Nos. 23-46-GA-ALT, et al.)

Summary: Columbia filed a settlement agreed upon or unopposed by all parties in its Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) Infrastructure Replacement Program (IRP) case.

The settlement significantly reduces the nearly \$200 million that Columbia initially proposed to collect from customers.

In addition to imposing fixed rates or rate caps for the General Sales (GS) or Large General Sales (LGS) rate classes, the settlement reduces the total amount that Columbia can collect by more than \$118 million; removes operational and maintenance expenses (reducing costs by more than \$2.3 million); decreases the amount that Columbia can collect from GS customers to \$8.9 million from \$21.9 million; decreases the amount Columbia can collect from LGS customers to \$4.3 million from \$10.6 million; and decreases the PHMSA Rider term.
