AEP

AEP Decreases Default SSO Rate

Summary: Based on recent competitive auctions, the default service rate for AEP decreased to \$0.0768/kWh from \$0.1132/kWh, effective June 1, 2024. Although the default rate decreased, customers should continue to check their competitive supplier contracts before choosing not to shop and switching to the SSO.

AES

AES Decreases Default SSO Rate

Summary: Based on recent competitive auctions, the default service rate for AES decreased to \$0.0858/kWh from \$0.1080709/kWh, effective June 1, 2024. Although the default rate decreased, customers should continue to check their competitive supplier contracts before choosing not to shop and switching to the SSO.

Centerpoint Energy (formerly Vectren)

Centerpoint Increases Default Standard Choice Offer (SCO) Rate

Summary: Based on recent competitive auctions, the default service rate for Centerpoint increased to \$0.3968/ccf from \$0.3027/ccf, effective June 1, 2024.

Duke

Duke Decreases Default SSO Rate

Summary: Based on recent competitive auctions, the default service rate for Duke decreased to \$0.0801/kWh from \$0.0982/kWh, effective June 1, 2024. Although the default rate decreased, customers should continue to check their competitive supplier contracts before choosing not to shop and switching to the SSO.

FirstEnergy

The FirstEnergy Utilities Update Rider Rates (Case Nos. 89-6001-EL-TRF, 89-6006-EL-TRF, and 89-6008-EL-TRF)

Summary: Effective July 1, 2024, each of the FirstEnergy Utilities will update their Generation Cost Reconciliation (GCR) Rider, Legacy Generation Resource Rider (Rider LGR), and Delta Revenue Recovery Riders (Rider DRR). Each of the Utilities will:

- Increase the GCR to \$0.004197/kWh from \$0.002035/kWh for General Service – Primary (GP), and to \$0.004348/kWh for General Service – Secondary (GS);
- Maintain the Rider LGR charge of \$0.001800/kWh for both GP and GS; and
- Decrease Rider DRR to \$0.000001/kWh from \$0.000002/kWh for GP, and to \$0.000002/kWh from \$0.000004/kWh for GS.

Furthermore, effective July 1, 2024, The Cleveland Illuminating Company will:

- Implement a Distribution Uncollectible (DUN) Rider credit of \$0.000135/kWh from a charge of \$0.000348/kWh for both GP and GS; and
- Implement a PIPP Uncollectible Rider (PUR) credit of \$0.000071/kWh from a charge of \$0.000021/kWh for both GP and GS.

The Ohio Edison Company will:

- Increase the DUN credit to \$0.000248/kWh from \$0.000164/kWh for both GP and GS;
- Implement a PUR credit of \$0.000039/kWh from a charge of \$0.000021/kWh for both GP and GS.

The Toledo Edison Company will:

- Implement a DUN credit of \$0.000011/kWh from a charge of \$0.000063/kWh for both GP and GS; and
- Implement a PUR credit of \$0.000023/kWh from a charge of \$0.000031/kWh for both GP and GS.

The FirstEnergy Utilities Decrease Default Standard Service Offer (SSO) Rates

Summary: Based on recent competitive auctions, the default service rates for the three FirstEnergy utilities changed as follows: the Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company's SSO rate decreased to \$0.094500/kWh from \$0.099800/kWh; Ohio Edison's SSO rate decreased to \$0.092900/kWh from \$0.101100/kWh; and Toledo Edison's SSO rate decreased to \$0.094200/kWh from \$0.104500/kWh, effective June 1, 2024.
