WOTC is a tax incentive program for businesses hiring individuals from one of several target groups Credits range from \$1,200 to \$9,600, based on the target group and number of hours worked.

Rapid Response is dedicated to averting layoffs and re-employment after layoffs occur.



ApprenticeOhio



- ★ ApprenticeOhio programs are an inexpensive way to build a highly skilled, motivated workforce. The programs emphasize learning by doing, and they are thriving. More than 19,000 registered apprentices are working in Ohio, in over 200 different occupations.
- ★ Programs can be sponsored by individual employers, trade associations, industry groups, or through partnerships with labor organizations.
- ★ With Apprenticeships, you can:
 - ★ Grow your own workforce
 - ★ Improve productivity and save money
 - ★ Teach the apprentices your company values
 - ★ Train workers the way your company wants them trained
 - ★ Reduce turnover costs and increase employee retention
 - ★ Potentially receive federal Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) funds
 - ★ Potentially receive the federal Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC)



Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC)

- ★ The Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC) is a federal tax credit available to employers who hire individuals from eligible target groups, including veterans.
- ★ Learn How to Participate for steps on accessing our online application and requesting certification. Employers or agents must apply for, and receive, certification to claim these tax credits. Agents acting on behalf of employers must send a valid Power of Attorney.
- ★ Online applications must be submitted in the Ohio WOTC portal within 28 days of the start to work date to meet the timely filing criteria.

Employers: Want to thank a veteran? Hire one.

Claim a tax credit for hiring a veteran who has a service-connected disability, is unemployed, or is a member of a family receiving SNAP (food stamp) benefits.

- Reduce your federal income tax liability by as much as \$9,600 per veteran hired.
- There is no limit on the number of individuals an employer can hire to qualify to claim the tax credit.
- Certain tax-exempt organizations can take advantage of WOTC by receiving a credit against the employer's share
 of Social Security taxes.







Veteran Priority in Employer Searches

Ohio National Guard Employer Programs

- ★ The Employer Support of the Guard and Reserve (ESGR) office is the lead U.S. Defense Department program promoting cooperation and understanding between civilian employers and their National Guard and Reserve employees. With an ESGR committee in each state, territory, and the District of Columbia, there is an ESGR representative able to help you forge a stronger bond with your military employees through a greater understanding of their military service.
- ★ The Ohio National Guard Employment Enhancement Program (NGEEP) has employment support specialists throughout Ohio who develop relationships with employers, apprenticeships, and businesses seeking to train and hire Veterans, service members, and Military Family members. The NGEEP has a map of regional contacts that can help share opportunities to units.

U.S. Department of Defense SkillBridge Program



- ★ Looking for transitioning service members returning to Ohio? The DOD SkillBridge Program may be able to help.
- ★ Helps active duty transitioning service members bridge the gap between their military service and their civilian careers during their last six months of service.
- ★ Employers, think of this program as an internship. The military pays their full salary and benefits, while employers get to "borrow a servicemember" at no cost and design a program that best fits their needs that may lead to a direct hire post-military service.

U.S. DOL HIRE Vets Medallion Program



- * The Honoring Investments in Recruiting and Employing American Military Veterans (HIRE Vets) Medallion Program is a federal-level award that recognizes employers who successfully recruit, employ, and retain America's veterans using set program criteria (e.g. % of new veteran hires).
- * Award recipients receive a certificate and digital images of the medallion for use as part of their marketing and promotional activities.
- ★ Annual employer application period January April and <u>awardees</u> announced annually around Veterans Day.
