Parties Request Reconsideration of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio's (PUCO) Dismissal of Numerous Cases

(Case Nos. 14-375-EL-RDR, et al.)

Summary: As you may recall, earlier this month, the Supreme Court of Ohio held that the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (PUCO) does not have the authority to grant itself more time to consider requests for reconsideration of its prior orders. The PUCO then issued an entry denying reconsideration requests in dozens of cases and ordering those cases closed. However, the PUCO's ambiguous language seems to imply that parties will not be able to appeal these cases to the Supreme Court of Ohio. Customer groups now seek reconsideration of the entry and request clarity on whether the statutory right to appeal PUCO decisions is being denied.

The FirstEnergy Utilities Adjust Non-Market-Base Services Rider (Rider NMB) Rates

(Case No. 24-0730-EL-RDR)

Summary: Effective October 1, 2024, the Rider NMB rates will be adjusted as follows:

- Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company will increase Rider NMB to \$10.1849/kW of billing demand from \$8.5652/kW of billing demand for General Service – Primary (GP), and to \$7.6850/kW of billing demand from \$6.8196/kW of billing demand for General Service – Secondary (GS);
- Ohio Edison will decrease Rider NMB to \$7.4228/kW of billing demand from \$8.6001/kW of billing demand for GP, and to \$6.0055/kW of billing demand from \$6.2252/kW of billing demand for GS; and
- Toledo Edison will decrease Rider NMB to \$6.4863/kW of billing demand from \$7.0647/kW of billing demand for GP, and to \$5.5931/kW of billing demand from \$5.9053/kW of billing demand for GS.
