### Statewide

#### **House Bill 6 (HB 6)-Created Coal and Solar Subsidies Terminated (Case Nos. 20-1118-EL-RDR, et al.)**

**Summary:** As you may recall, the recently passed House Bill 15 eliminated the coal and solar subsidies created by HB 6. OMAEG recently filed a motion requesting that the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (PUCO) order the electric distribution utilities (EDUs) to file new tariffs reflecting the end of the subsidies. In response, the PUCO directed the EDUs to file compliance tariffs setting their respective rates for the riders collecting the subsidies to zero, effective August 14, 2015. Those tariffs were approved this week.

### FirstEnergy

#### **OMAEG Seeks Restitution For Customers For FirstEnergy's HB 6 Conspiracy (Case Nos. 17-974-EL-UNC, et al.)**

**Summary:** This week, OMAEG filed its [reply brief](#) urging the PUCO to dismiss FirstEnergy's arguments that subsequent compliance and supposed remediation measures are sufficient to erase the numerous harms done to Ohio customers by FirstEnergy's HB 6 scheme and other corruption. OMAEG further urged the PUCO to make Ohioans whole by (1) ordering FirstEnergy to provide refunds to customers of the money collected from customers to fund corrupt activities, (2) imposing steep monetary penalties for FirstEnergy's years of corruption and misconduct, and (3) initiating real audits to determine the full extent of the Ohio law and PUCO rule violations that took place in relation to the HB 6 conspiracy, bribes, undisclosed side deals, and other unlawful behavior.
