**The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (PUCO) Schedules Workshop for New Rate Case Rules  
(Case No. 25-815-AU-ORD)**

**Summary:** As you may recall, the recently signed House Bill 15 allows electric light companies to set their rates based on forecasted revenues and expenses, meaning that rates will no longer be based on revenues and expenses incurred during an established test year. To comply with the new law, the PUCO issued proposed rate case rule amendments this week and invited interested stakeholders to a workshop on November 6, 2025 to offer feedback and comments. The PUCO Staff has proposed a set of rules for electric utilities that choose to file forecasted rate cases separate from the rules that have, and will continue to, govern traditional ratemaking cases.
